



Announcement of Khuenchangwittayakarn School

Subject: No Gift Policy

In accordance with the resolution of the Cabinet on December 8, 2020, which approved the national reform plan on preventing and combating corruption and misconduct (revised edition), it has been determined to drive the implementation of key reform activities (Big Rock). Reform activity 5 focuses on developing the Thai civil service system to be transparent and free from conflicts of interest. Objective 1, item 1.1, mandates that all government agencies declare themselves as entities where every official does not accept gifts or any kind of gratuities in the course of their duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, to drive the reform activities in line with the national reform plan mentioned above, to enhance transparency within the organization, and to instill values in performing duties, Khuenchangwittayakarn School hereby announces a policy that all administrators, teachers, and educational personnel within the school must not accept gifts or gratuities of any kind in the course of their duties (No Gift Policy) on all festive occasions and special events. Exceptions are made only when it is unavoidable, in which case the acceptance of gifts or gratuities must comply with the rules set forth in the Prime Minister's Office Regulation on the Giving or Acceptance of Gifts by State Officials, B.E. 2001, along with the announcement by the National Anti-Corruption Commission regarding the criteria for accepting assets or other benefits by state officials under ethical standards, B.E. 2020.

This announcement is made for public acknowledgment and adherence by all.
