Mr. Chumpol Suwichian, the principal of Phichitpittayakom School, hereby announces the policy of not accepting any kind of gifts or rewards for performing duties. Furthermore, all administrators, teachers, and staff members of Phichitpittayakom School hereby announce their intention to not accept any gifts or gratuities of any kind in performance to their duties (No Gift Policy), whether before, during, or after the performance of their duties, as this can lead to corruption and misconduct both in the present and in the future. By collectively fostering a culture of integrity within the organization, we aim to instill and awaken moral consciousness. This involves cultivating attitudes and values that promote discernment between personal interests and the welfare of the collective. Based on the mindset of prioritizing the collective welfare over personal interests, we are dedicated to serving the public with a sense of duty and public-mindedness, undertaking governmental duties with accuracy, transparency, equity, and impartiality, while abstaining from any actions that may present a conflict between personal interests and the collective welfare. We will decline any possessions or benefits that may be monetarily quantifiable from any individual, except those assets or benefits rightfully entitled by laws, regulations, or mandates established by legal authority, unless it involves receiving assets or other benefits that are ethically justified, in accordance with the criteria and quantities stipulated by the National Anti-Corruption Commission. Additionally, this includes adhering to the ethical standards set for government officials and the guidelines for giving or receiving gifts or any other benefits, applicable to officials at all levels within Phichitpittayakom School. Moreover, we will strictly adhere to all pertinent laws, regulations, and cabinet resolutions to ensure that Phichitpittayakom School remains free from corruption and misconduct.
