

## Announcement from The Bannongchumsang School, regarding the Declaration of the No Gift Policy.

I, Mrs. Nattanan Dabthong, Director of the Bannongchumsang School, as the highest executive of the Bannongchumsang School, hereby announce the No Gift Policy. Furthermore, I declare the commitment of the executives, officers, and all personnel in the Bannongchumsang School, as an organization where executives, officers, and all personnel do not accept gifts and rewards of any kind from carrying out their duties. This applies before, during, and after duty, to prevent corruption and misconduct, both presently and in the future. We will work together to foster a culture of integrity within the organization by instilling a sense of conscience, cultivating attitudes, and promoting good values in performing duties, prioritizing the collective benefits of civil servants, teachers, and educational personnel, students, and the public over personal gain. Public duty must be carried out correctly, honestly, transparently, justly, without favoritism, without exploiting one's position for personal gain or that of associates, without actions that conflict personal interests with the collective good. No property or other benefits that may be valued in monetary terms shall be accepted from anyone unless it is necessary and unavoidable. Compliance with the criteria for accepting gifts or benefits and other benefits shall be in accordance with the regulations of the Prime Minister's Office regarding the giving or receiving of gifts by state officials, B.E. 2544, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission's criteria for accepting property or other benefits, based on the moral principles of state officials, B.E. 2563.

This announcement is made for general information, and all executives, officers, and personnel under this jurisdiction are required to adhere to the No Gift Policy.
